

EU regulation 2022/428

for import of Steel and Iron from Russia

Response to COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) 2022/428 of 15 March 2022 amending Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 concerning restrictive measures on the import of Russian Steel and Iron.

It shall be prohibited to sell, supply, transfer or export, directly or indirectly, goods or technology, as listed in Annex XVII, whether or not originating in the Union, to any natural or legal person, entity or body in Russia, including its Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf, or for use in Russia, including its Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf.
